About you

Add your name and address if your details are not pre-printed on this Form. A telephone or email address will help us contact you quickly should we have a query with your application; these details will not be passed on to another person.

Ensure that all the information you enter is written clearly and in **BLOCK CAPITALS**.

Your date of birth and signature

You must enter your Date of Birth in the format DD/MM/YYYY (e.g. if born on 10 June 1960 enter 10 06 1960) and then sign the Form in the box supplied.

Please note that these details must be kept within the borders provided. Failure to do so will mean that your application will not be valid.

Date

The application must include the date at the bottom left of the Form.

Postal vote for which Election/referendum?

You can choose to vote by post at different types of election/poll. If you are unsure, then we would recommend that you choose to vote at "ALL" as you may otherwise lose your vote in one poll if there is more than one taking place on the same day.

For how long do you want a postal vote?

You need to decide if you wish to have a postal vote:

- * until you tell us otherwise;
- * for a particular date when you know that there is a poll;
- * for all polls held between two dates (you may be on holiday or otherwise unable to vote in person at a polling station between these dates)

Address for the ballot paper(s)

Either tick the box to confirm that the ballot paper(s) should be sent to the address where you are registered to vote **or**, if you will be away from home, then you can choose to have your ballot paper(s) sent to an address other than your registered address.

You **MUST** give a reason for such a request.

Posting of Ballot Papers

Postal ballot papers are usually posted around a fortnight before the day of an election. If you are in any doubt as to your situation, please contact us for advice.

Future Change of Name or Address

If you change your name in the future, for example, because of marriage, please let us know as your details and signature will need to be updated. If you change address, then as well as needing to apply to be registered to vote there, you will need to make a further application to vote by post in respect of the new address.

Students – Away Address

If you are a student and (i) ask for the ballot paper to go to an address other than where you are registered to vote; and (ii) request a postal vote until further notice, please bear in mind that you may need to update the address for the ballot paper at the start of the next academic year.

Under 18s

If you have not yet reached your 18th birthday, then please note that the arrangements described in this letter will become effective when you do.
