Garden waste collection charges: NEW

From April, garden waste collections will cost £30 per bin, per year. Registration details, including how to pay, will be available in the New Year.

Please separate your glass items: NEW

In October 2017 you will be given a new wheelie bin for your recycling but glass will still be collected in a black box. Prepare for this by separating it now, leaving remaining recyclables, unsorted, in your other box(es).

Recycling boxes

- Glass bottles / jars - please separate into one recycling box
- Cardboard / cartons
- Foil / tins / cans / aerosols
- Paper / magazines
- Plastic bottles / pots / tubs
- Dry textiles / shoes
- Non-rechargeable batteries
- Car batteries *
- Oil *

Food caddy / bin

- **ANY** food: cooked or raw
- You can put food waste loose into your caddy, line it with newspaper or use compostable liners.

Please remember: Put the correct containers out by 6am on your collection day. Once emptied, put your bins/boxes back within your property boundary.

* These items should be left beside your respective bin. Engine oil and larger quantities of cooking oil should be put in separate sealed, labelled containers (eg a plastic bottle but not glass) for collection.

Garden waste bin

- For loose green garden waste **ONLY** eg grass cuttings, flowers, leaves, weeds etc.
- No plastic bags**

Household rubbish bin

- For anything that cannot be recycled. This will be taken to an energy recovery facility at Ardley.
- No food waste**
