I'd just like to comment that I am in agreement with the suggestions made in the Eynsham Neighbourhood Development Plan. I believe this offers a good way forward which should ensure that new development in Eynsham is sustainable and proportionate. I agree that Eynsham would be a good location for new homes, and feel that the size of development proposed in the Eynsham Neighbourhood Development Plan (roughly 750 houses) is appropriate to the size of the existing community. I am concerned that if WODC's plans go ahead for more than 3000 new houses in and around Eynsham, many of the current benefits of living in Eynsham risk being lost.

Unlike the WODC plans, the Eynsham Neighbourhood Development Plan has been created in consultation with people who currently live in Eynsham, and it takes many residents' valid concerns into account.

The Eynsham Neighbourhood Development Plan allows for a sustainable level of new housing, not the 150% expansion in size of the existing community that WODC proposes. This in turn makes it easier to ensure that appropriate new infrastructure and services for the new houses and new residents can be provided in a well-planned and timely manner (which is a major concern regarding WODC's plans).

I'd therefore like to add my voice to those calling for the adoption of the Eynsham Neighbourhood Development Plan in preference to the WODC plans.
