All the designated green open spaces in the ENP are particularly important since the village is so densely populated. The old railway, that is part of a circular walk which took several years to get owners to agree and to be approved by OCC, is of extra importance. It also has a significant number of species of plants, special to that very well drained area, and animals, including adders. Shifting the path to the field won't work as the habitat off the old railway line is different.
