I strongly support the Neighbourhood Plan. It has been developed in full consultation with Eynsham residents and with detailed knowledge of the village's topography, transport connections, infrastructure and the realities of living in Eynsham. In particular the Plan identifies a more clearly thought-out and sustainable rate of housing growth for the future than the hasty, vague, and hugely inflated plans of WODC. The combined proposed developments to the west and north of the A40 will destroy the very qualities that give Eynsham its unique character: a compact network of streets where all facilities are within walking distance, easy access to the countryside, and a strong community spirit. If the Garden Village to the north of the A40 gets planning permission, I strongly support the Neighbourhood Plan proposal to enable future re-routing of the A40 at Eynsham, further north of the village, and to refuse new housing south of Chilbridge Road.

There are alternative locations for new housing developments that have not been properly explored by WODC, and that would not have such a significant impact on Eynsham and in particular on transport to and through the village with consequent increase in environmental pollution. The private developer plans for a second garden village at South Leigh MUST be considered as an alternative to the garden village north of the A40, and not as an additional development; a total of some 6000 new houses would put intolerable strain on Eynsham, and on the A40 that no road improvement could mitigate.
