I hope you will also take into account the ENP Consultation Statement regarding the questionnaire responses to the public consultation before October 5%. The fact that 81% of respondents indicated that they did not oppose a new village, of a self-selecting group taking high interest in village developments, demonstrates significant support for the development that should not be ignored.

That there are still questions to answer about process and infrastructure should not be to the detriment of providing homes.
