# WEST OXFORDSHIRE DISRICT COUNCIL (OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES) No. 1 ORDER 2021

WEST OXFORDSHIRE DISTRICT COUNCIL ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 32, 33, 35 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act") and under the Road Traffic Act 1991 as amended (whether generally or in relation to the area of the Council) ("the 1991 Act") and of all other enabling powers, with the consent of the Oxfordshire County Council in accordance with Section 39(3) of the 1984 Act and after consulting with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with paragraph 20 of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, hereby make the following Order:-

### PART I GENERAL

### Commencement and Citation

1. This Order shall come into operation on the [\forall ] day of [\forall \( \lambda \) \( \lambda \

#### Interpretation

2. In this Order, except where the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings respectively assigned to them:

"Civil Enforcement Officer" means a person authorised by or on behalf of the Council to supervise the Parking Place and enforce the restrictions imposed by this Order

"Disabled Persons' Badge" has the meaning given in Section 142 (1) of the 1984 Act

"Disabled Persons' Vehicle" has the meaning given in Section 142 (1) of the 1984 Act

"**Driver**" in relation to a vehicle waiting in a Parking Place means an able-bodied person driving the vehicle at the time it was left in a Parking Bay or the person deemed to be the Driver under the terms of this Order

"Electric Vehicle" means any vehicle which uses one or more electric motors for propulsion

"Electric Vehicle Charging Bay" means an area of a Parking Place which is provided for the leaving of an Electric Vehicle and marked for Electric Vehicles and where apparatus which supplies electricity for the charging of Electric Vehicles is installed

"Emergency Services" means the Police, Fire and Ambulance Services

"Motor Car" has the same meaning as in Section 136 (2) of the 1984 Act and shall include a "heavy motor car" as defined by Section 136 (3) of the 1984 Act and an Electric Vehicle as defined in this Order

"Motor Cycle" has the meaning assigned to it by Section 136 of the 1984 Act

"**Motor Vehicle**" has the meaning assigned to it by Section 136(1) of the 1984 Act and should be read to include Electric Vehicles

"Owner" means the person in whose name the vehicle was at that time registered under the Vehicle Excise and Registration Act 1994

"Parking Bay" means an area of a Parking Place which is provided for the leaving of a vehicle of a class specified and indicated by markings on the surface of the Parking Place or signed or otherwise indicated by signs in the Parking Place

#### "Parking Permit" means either:

- a) a ticket or permit issued by the Council (or their authorised representative or agent for a Parking Place) to be displayed in the Relevant Position; or
- b) an electronic record authorising the holder to park the nominated Motor Car in one or more Parking Places nominated by the Council and valid for the parking period and Parking

Places as specified and subject to conditions or limitations which may be imposed on its use

"Parking Place" means any area of land specified by name in the First Schedule and provided by the Council pursuant to Section 32(1) of the 1984 Act for use as an off-street car park and not closed (in part or in whole) by a notice, sign or barrier erected thereon by authority of the Council

"Penalty Charge" has the same meaning as in Section 78 of the Traffic Management Act 2004

"Penalty Charge Notice" means a notice issued or served by a Civil Enforcement Officer pursuant to the provisions of Section 78 of the Traffic Management Act 2004

"Relevant Position" means in the case of a Disabled Persons' Badge, Part 1 (the front of the badge), is exhibited in a conspicuous position facing forward on or inside the vehicle and can easily be viewed by the Civil Enforcement Officer from the front of the vehicle

"**Trailer**" means a vehicle drawn by a Motor Vehicle and includes a caravan or boat trailer

- 3. Except where the context requires otherwise, any reference in this Order to an Article or Schedule shall be construed as a reference to that Article or Schedule in this Order
- 4. Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment
- 5. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order

# PART II DESIGNATION AND USE OF PARKING PLACES

#### Designation

6. The Parking Places may be used, subject to the provisions of this Order, as a place to leave vehicles of such classes, in such positions, on such days, during such hours and for such period as are specified in relation thereto in the First Schedule and on such terms and conditions as are advertised at each Parking Place.

#### Class and position of vehicle

- 7. Where in the First Schedule the Parking Place is described as available for vehicles of a specified class or vehicles to be left in a specified location, no person shall permit a vehicle to wait in that Parking Place,
  - (i) unless it is of the specified class;
  - (ii) unless it is wholly within a marked Parking Bay;
  - (iii) in a Parking Bay marked for use by a Disabled Persons' Vehicle unless it is a Disabled Persons' Vehicle which displays in the Relevant Position a Disabled Persons Badge;
  - (iv) in a Parking Bay marked for use by an Electric Vehicle unless it is a Electric Vehicle which is charging using the apparatus installed;
  - (v) in a Parking Bay marked for use by parent and child unless the Driver or a passenger is accompanied by a child; and
  - (vi) in a position other than that specified.

#### Maximum period of stay

8. Where in the First Schedule the Parking Place is described as available on specified days, during specified hours or for a maximum period of stay, no person shall permit a vehicle to park or wait in that Parking Place on any day, during such hours or for any period other or longer than those specified

#### Period of no return

9. Where in the First Schedule the Parking Place is described as having a period within which a vehicle may not return, no person shall permit a vehicle to wait in the Parking Place on any day, during such hours within which the vehicle is excluded from waiting in the Parking Place

#### Power to close or suspend Parking Places

10. Nothing in this Order shall prevent the Council or its representative by notice, sign or barrier displayed in the Parking Place:

- (i) from closing the Parking Place or any part thereof for any period; and/or
- (ii) from setting aside the Parking Place or any part or parts thereof on all days or on certain days or during certain parts of days for use only by particular vehicles or organisations
- 11. Any person suspending the use of the Parking Place or any part thereof in accordance with the provisions of Article 10 shall thereupon place or cause to be placed in or adjacent to the Parking Place or that part thereof a notice, sign or barrier indicating that the use of the Parking Place or that part thereof is suspended and that waiting by vehicles is prohibited
- 12. No person shall cause or permit a vehicle to be left in the Parking Place or any part thereof during such periods that the use of the Parking Place or that part thereof is suspended or during such period as there is in or adjacent thereto a notice, sign or barrier placed by or on behalf of the Council in pursuance of the preceding Article 10 and Article 11

#### Parking Permits

- 13. Parking Permits may be issued by the Council (or their authorised representative or agent a Parking Place), for a vehicle of a specific class and for a specific Parking Place subject to terms and conditions determined by the Council
- 14. The Driver shall abide by the terms stipulated by the Council for the use of the Parking Permit
- 15. A Parking Permit is only valid in the Parking Place(s) in respect of which it was issued and up to the date of expiry shown on the Parking Permit
- 16. A Parking Permit remains the property of the Council and must be surrendered on request.
- 17. Nothing in Article 8 (Maximum period of stay) and Article 9 (Period of no return) shall preclude a vehicle subject to a valid Parking Permit from being parked in the relevant Parking Places as specified and subject to conditions or limitations which may be imposed on the use of the Parking Permit.

#### **PART IV**

#### **RELOCATION AND REMOVAL OF VEHICLES**

#### Relocation of a vehicle

18. Where any vehicle is standing in the Parking Place in contravention of the provisions of this Order, or is left in such a manner so as to cause danger or obstruction, a Civil Enforcement Officer or a person authorised by the Council may alter or cause to be altered the position of the vehicle

#### Removal of a vehicle

19. Where a Civil Enforcement Officer or a person authorised by the Council is of the opinion that any of the provisions contained in this Order have been contravened or not complied with in respect of a vehicle left in the Parking Place he/she may, using such measures as are appropriate, remove or cause to be removed the vehicle from the Parking Place

#### Emergencies

20. A Civil Enforcement Officer, a person authorised by the Council or a member of the Emergency Services in uniform may, using such measures as are appropriate, move or cause to be moved in the case of an emergency to any place he/she thinks fit, any vehicle left in the Parking Place

#### Safe keeping

21. Any person removing a vehicle from the Parking Place under the preceding Articles shall make such arrangements as may be reasonably necessary to provide for the safe keeping of the vehicle

#### **PART V**

#### **OTHER PROVISIONS**

#### Stop engine and apply brakes

22. The Driver of a Motor Vehicle using the Parking Place shall, subject to the following proviso stop the engine as soon as the vehicle is in the Parking Bay and shall not start the engine except when about to change the position of the vehicle in or to depart from the Parking Place PROVIDED THAT in the case of a Motor Vehicle which is fitted with equipment to assist disabled passengers to

alight from or board the vehicle, where the vehicle's engine is required to operate that equipment the Driver shall stop the engine as soon as the vehicle is in the Parking Bay and the equipment has been used to assist all the disabled passengers travelling in the vehicle to alight from it and shall not start the engine except when the equipment is required to assist disable d passengers to board the vehicle or when about to change the position of the vehicle in or to depart from the Parking Place;

23. The Driver of a Motor Vehicle using the Parking Place shall, except in the case of a Motor Cycle, set or apply the braking system of the vehicle so as to prevent effectually at least two, or in the case of a vehicle with three wheels or less, one, of the wheels from revolving when the vehicle is not being driven or is left unattended

#### Repair of vehicles in the Parking Place

24. No person shall, while a vehicle is in the Parking Place, permit the carrying out of any work of maintenance or repair thereto except such as may be necessary to enable the vehicle to be moved from the Parking Place

#### Vehicle Tax and Insurance

- 25. No person shall permit any vehicle to wait in the Parking Place unless:
  - 25.1 the vehicle is licensed in pursuant of the provisions of the Vehicle Excise and Registration Act 1994;
  - 25.2 there is in relation to the use of the vehicle by the Driver such a policy of insurance as complies with requirements of the Road Traffic Act 1988;

#### **Entry and Exit**

- 26. Where signs are erected or surface markings are laid for the purpose of indicating the entrances to or exits from the Parking Place; or indicating that a vehicle proceed in a specified direction, no person shall drive or cause to be driven any vehicle;
  - 26.1 so that it enters the Parking Place otherwise than by an entrance, or leaves the Parking Place otherwise than by an exit;
  - 26.2 in a direction other than that specified, as the case may be:
  - 26.3 otherwise in a manner or at a speed so as to cause danger to other users of the Parking Place

except by express permission of a Civil Enforcement Officer, a person authorised by the Council or a member of the Emergency Services in uniform in the event of an emergency.

#### Use of vehicles and the Parking Place

- 27. No person shall in the Parking Place:
  - 27.1 without the express written permission of the Council, use a vehicle, in connection with the sale of any article, including the vehicle itself, to any person in or near the Parking Place or in connection with the selling or offering for hire of skill or services in any other capacity;
  - 27.2 sound any horn or other similar instrument except when about to change the position of the vehicle or to depart from the Parking Place;
  - 27.3 except with the permission or at the direction of a Civil Enforcement Officer or a person authorised by the Council or a police constable in uniform, drive or permit to be driven any vehicle for any purpose other than for the purpose of leaving the vehicle in the Parking Place in accordance with the provisions of this Order or for the purpose of departing from the Parking Place or for the purpose of visiting any amenity site in the Parking Place;
  - 27.4 use any part of the Parking Place or a vehicle in the Parking Place without the express written permission of the Council for;
    - (a) sleeping or camping purposes;
    - (b) cooking purposes;
    - (c) the purpose of washing, valeting or servicing any vehicle
  - 27.5 use the Parking Place solely as a means of passage proceeding from one road to another;
  - 27.6 deposit or leave any vehicle, Trailer, or anything which formed part of a vehicle or Trailer, or any rubbish, litter or anything with the purpose of abandoning it there
  - 27.7 wantonly shout, play music or permit music to be played or otherwise make any noise to cause disturbance or annoyance to users of the Parking Place or residents or other occupiers of adjacent premises;
  - 27.8 act in a manner to cause nuisance or danger to any Parking Place user, resident or other person;
  - 27.9 without the express written permission of the Council, erect or cause or permit to be erected, any tent, booth, stand, building or other structure;
  - 27.10 light or cause to be lit a fire;

- 27.11play any game, ball game or participate in any sporting or recreational activity;
- 27.12use any threatening, abusive or insulting language, gesture or conduct with the intent to intimidate, put any person in fear or so as to occasion a breach of the peace or whereby a breach of the peace is likely to be occasioned;
- 27.13carry on any trade or business of whatever description without the prior written consent of the Council;
- 27.14distribute, allow to be or cause to be distributed or place on any vehicle any literature, advertising material or handbill except with the prior written consent of the Council and upon payment of a fee determined by the Council
- 27.15transfer fuel out of or into a vehicle except where necessary to allow the vehicle to be driven away
- 27.16drive a vehicle in the Parking Place at a speed in excess of 10 miles per hour.
- 27.17 use a vehicle in contravention of the directions of a Civil Enforcement Officer

#### Animals and Parking Places

- 28. No dog or other animal shall be allowed to foul the Parking Place.
- 29 Any animals in the Parking Place shall be kept under control
- 30. Sufficient ventilation and other comforts shall be provided if an animal is left in a vehicle in the Parking Place
- 31. Where it is considered by the Civil Enforcement Officer or a person authorised by the Council or a police constable in uniform that an animal is suffering due to being kept in an enclosed vehicle in hot or inappropriate conditions it shall be the duty of that person to take whatever action is considered necessary to relieve that suffering including the breakage of window, glass or locks of the vehicle
- 32. Large animals such as horses and farm livestock shall not be permitted to enter the Parking Place except as herein reserved

#### **Emergency Services Vehicles**

33. All vehicles belonging to the Emergency Services when attending any emergency may use the Parking Place and be exempt from compliance with any of the conditions specified in this Order

## PART VI

#### Liability

34. The Council accepts no liability for the loss or damage to any vehicle, or the fittings or contents or any vehicle or other property waiting, moving in, entering or leaving or otherwise using the Parking Place to which this Order applies

# PART VII CONTRAVENTION AND PENALTY CHARGE

#### Contravention

35. If a vehicle is left in the Parking Place without complying with the requirements of this Order, a contravention shall have occurred and a Penalty Charge shall be payable. A Penalty Charge Notice showing the information required by the Traffic Management Act 2004 may then be issued by a Civil Enforcement Officer in accordance with the requirements of the Traffic Management Act 2004

#### Notice of Penalty Charge

36. In the case of a vehicle in respect of which the Penalty Charge may have been incurred, it shall be the duty of a Civil Enforcement Officer to attach to the vehicle in a conspicuous position a Penalty Charge Notice in accordance with the Traffic Management Act 2004

#### Restriction on removal of notices

- 37. A Penalty Charge Notice fixed to a vehicle in accordance with the preceding Article shall not be removed or interfered with except by or under the authority of:
  - 37.1 the Owner, the Driver or person in charge of the vehicle;
  - 37.2 a Civil Enforcement Officer or some other person duly authorised by the Council

#### Payment of Penalty Charge

38. The Penalty Charge shall be payable by the person liable under the provisions of the Traffic Management Act 2004 in accordance with the terms and conditions as stated on the Penalty Charge Notice

#### Indications as Evidence

39. The particulars given in the Penalty Charge Notice attached to a vehicle in accordance with this Order shall be treated as evidence in any proceedings relating to failure to pay such Penalty Charge

#### **PART VIII**

#### **NOTICES**

40. Where under the foregoing provisions of this Order a notice is required to be or may be sent to a person the notice shall be sent by prepaid post

## PART IX REVOCATIONS

41. The Orders specified in the Second Schedule to this Order are hereby revoked.







Map Title:	Guildenford Car Park, Burford








Map Title:	Albion Street Car Park, Chipping Norton









Map Title:	New Street Car Park, Chipping Norton








Map Title:	Riley Close Car Park, Long Hanborough



















Map Title:	Hensington Road Car Park, Woodstock






## THE SECOND SCHEDULE

### **ORDERS TO BE REVOKED**
