
Floor plan guidance for HMO licence applications

Floor plans must be provided to support your HMO application. They do not need to be perfectly to scale nor architectural drawings – but these can be submitted it you have them. Below is a good example of hand drawn floor plans, they are not to scale but are representative of the actual layout and note the, front, fire safety items, facilities, room dimensions and calculated floor areas.



Key to common abbreviations
